13. 1 Corinthians 10:31

So, whether you eat or drink,
or whatever you do,
do all to the glory of God.

14. I Corinthians 15:58

Therefore, my beloved brothers,
be steadfast, immovable, always abounding
in the work of the Lord, knowing that
in the Lord your labor is not in vain.

15. II Corinthians 4:8-10

We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; 9 persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; 10 always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our bodies.

16. II Corinthians 13:11

19. Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace you have been saved through faith.
And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God,
9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

20. Ephesians 4:1-3


I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called,
2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,

21. Philippians 2:6-8

Who, though he was in the form of God,
did not count equality with God a thing to
be grasped, 7 but emptied himself,
by taking the form of a servant,
being born in the likeness of men.

8 And being found in human form, he
humbled himself by becoming obedient to
the point of death, even death on a cross.






22. Philippians 4:6-7

**Do not be anxious about anything,
but in everything by prayer and
supplication with thanksgiving let your
requests be made known to God.**


**7 And the peace of God, which surpasses
all understanding, will guard your hearts
and your minds in Christ Jesus.**





23. Colossians 1:16


For by him all things were created,
in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible,
whether thrones or dominions or rulers or
authorities—all things were created through
him and for him.





24. Colossians 3:16-17

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. 17 And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.





25. I Thessalonians 1:2-3

**We give thanks to God always for all of you,
constantly mentioning you in our prayers,
3 remembering before our God and Father
your work of faith and labor of love and
steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.**




26. // Thessalonians 2:15

So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter.



27. I Timothy 2:1-2

First of all, then, I urge that supplications,
prayers, intercessions, and
thanksgivings be made for all people,
2 for kings and all who are in high positions,
that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life,
godly and dignified in every way.





28. II Timothy 3:16

All Scripture is breathed out by God
and profitable for teaching,
for reproof, for correction,
and for training in righteousness.




29. Titus 3:6-7

Whom he poured out on us richly
through Jesus Christ our Savior,
7 so that being justified by his grace
we might become heirs according to
the hope of eternal life.



30. Philemon 4-6

I thank my God always when I remember you in my prayers, 5 because I hear of your love and of the faith that you have toward the Lord Jesus and for all the saints, 6 and I pray that the sharing of your faith may become effective for the full knowledge of every good thing that is in us for the sake of Christ.





31. Hebrews 10:24-25

**And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,
25 not neglecting to meet together,
as is the habit of some,
but encouraging one another, and all the
more as you see the Day drawing near.**



32. James 1:17

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.



33. 1 Peter 5:5

**Likewise, you who are younger,
be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves,
all of you, with humility toward one another,
for “God opposes the proud but gives grace
to the humble.**



34. II Peter 3:8-9

But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.



35. I John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.



36. II John 7-8

For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh.

Such a one is the deceiver and the antichrist.

8 Watch yourselves, so that you may not lose what we have worked for, but may win a full reward.



37. III John 2

**Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you
and that you may be in good health, as it goes
well with your soul.**



38. Jude 20-21

**But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit,
21 keep yourselves in the love of God,
waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that
leads to eternal life.**



39. Revelation 4:11
